The Mirpuri Foundation is a not-for-profit organization that aims to create a better world for future generations, working in six different areas: Marine Conservation, Wildlife Conservation, Performing Arts, Medical Education and Research, Aeronautical Education and Research and Social Responsibility. We strive to foster a spirit of collaboration between global authorities, companies, communities and individuals to positively impact the most pressing issues threatening our planet. The Mirpuri Foundation has grown to become an institution of established influence, setting the bar, leading by example and sharing its best practices to build a better world.

To name a few examples of our projects, we sponsored the Turn the Tide on Plastic boat competing in the 2017-17 Volvo Ocean Race and carried an innovative and groundbreaking scientific equipment onboard that collected water samples and mapped plastic pollution all over the world.
