- ❖ National Executive Ministry of the Colombian Government in charge of formulating, implementing, and orienting environmental policies to ensure the sustainable development of the country.

Lead Institution of the National Environmental System with the support of:

- 33 Regional Autonomous Environmental Authorities
- 7 Large City Autonomous Environmental Authorities
- National Environmental Licensing Authority
- National Natural Parks System
- Five Research Institutes





Colombia's Coastal and Marine Area

- Only South American Country with both Caribbean and Pacific Coasts
- Total **Coastline** of approximately **3,000km**
- Extensive **Marine Area** of **928,660km²** (45% of total territory)





Coastal & Marine Biodiversity

- ❖ Colombia's Marine and Coastal areas host a diverse range of ecosystems rich in biodiversity
 - Coral Reefs
 - Mangroves
 - Seagrass Beds
 - Beaches
 - Wetlands
 - Seamounts
 - Deep Ocean Water





Colombia's Coral Reefs

- Total Reef Surface Area: **2,861km²**
- The Archipelago of San Andres, Old Providence, and Santa Catalina contains 76% of Colombia's coral reefs and is a **Western Caribbean Coral Reef Hotspot**
- The remaining 24% of Colombia's coral reefs are distributed along the continental coastlines of the Caribbean and Pacific





Threats to Colombia's Coral Reefs

❖ Numerous natural and human induced threats (global, national, local) endanger the health the Colombia's Coral Reefs and associated ecosystems:

- Coral Bleaching
- Sedimentation/Siltation
- Over-Fishing
- Urban Development
- Algae Proliferation
- Invasive Species (Lionfish)
- Coral Diseases (White Plague/Black Spot Disease)






Legal & Policy Framework

- Colombia's National Development Plan (Law 1450/2011)
 - **Article 207:** Calls for the conservation of coral reefs, mangroves and seagrass ecosystems
 - **Article 208:** Granted marine jurisdiction to the coastal regional autonomous corporations
- National Environmental Policy for the Sustainable Development of the Ocean, Coastal Areas, and Islands (PNAOCl)
- National Policy for the Integrated Management of Biodiversity and Its Ecosystem Services (PNGIBSE)





Initiatives/Strategies

- Marine Protected Areas (MPAs)
 - Two MPAs listed under SPAW Protocol
- National and Regional Parks
- National Action Plans

- Coral Reef Monitoring System of Colombia (SIMAC)
- National Coral Reef Restoration Protocol (pilot phase)




Figure 1. Initial (left) and final condition (right) of some of the juvenile corals surveyed in Tesoro Island. (A) *Agaricia agaricites* found partially bleached, (B) *A. agaricites* found partially smothered by algae, and (C) *Diploria strigosa* found healthy.




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Maps of Coral Reef Locations







Deep-Water Coral National Natural Park

(Part of Rosario and San Bernardo MPA- Coral coverage = 134.5 km²)



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


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Maps of Coral Reef Locations

(Coral Coverage = 74.4km²)



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


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Quitasueño Bank

(Coral Coverage = 29.8 km²)




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Providencia and Santa Catalina Islands

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


(Coral Coverage = 30.2 km²)






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
Maps of Coral Reef Locations

Pacific Region





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


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Gorgona Island



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Challenges

- Increase scientific and technical information on coral coverage (especially deep-water corals)
